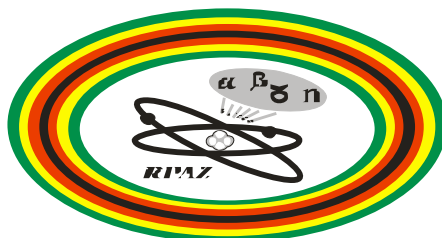

PRESS STATEMENT

RENEWAL OF LICENCES FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY-DECEMBER 2020

The Radiation Protection Authority of Zimbabwe (RPAZ) is a statutory body established under the Radiation Protection Act [Chapter 15:15] of 2004 with a mandate to protect people and the environment against effects of radiation.

The Authority hereby notifies **all** users of ionising radiation and radiation related equipment and service providers to start processing their licence renewals for 2020 in line with the provisions of Statutory Instrument 40 of 2020 and other related regulations. The renewal for the year 2020 licenses is open as from February 10, 2020.

All renewal processes must be concluded by 10 March 2020. Any application for renewal submitted after this date shall attract a 50% penalty fee charged in accordance with Statutory Instrument 40 of 2020.

It is illegal to operate radiation emitting devices and provide related service without a valid licence from the Radiation Protection Authority of Zimbabwe. All such entities and persons are required to regularise their operations with the Authority with immediate effect.
